

How We Help . . .



PASREP helps break the barrier to going back to work by assisting with out of pocket personal assistance costs. This can help bridge the funding gap caused by lost benefits. PASREP recipients receive reimbursements for personal assistance services up to \$1000 per month.

Am I Eligible?

To qualify for program assistance, you must be a Michigan resident and meet the following PASREP eligibility requirements. If you have questions, contact your regional representative (see back page for phone and e-mail).

You may qualify if you:

- Have a functionally significant disability.
- Are employed, or have an offer of employment working a minimum of 24 hrs./wk., and earning at least minimum wage.
- Require at least five hours of personal assistance each week.
- Are able to employ and manage personal assistants, maintain records, pay required taxes and file timely reports.
- Are paying out of pocket for personal assistance expenses.

How to Apply . . .

If you are currently employed or actively looking for a job, contact your regional representative (see back page for phone and e-mail).

* Final PASREP eligibility is determined when your name reaches the top of the waitlist. See “Am I Eligible” for program requirements.

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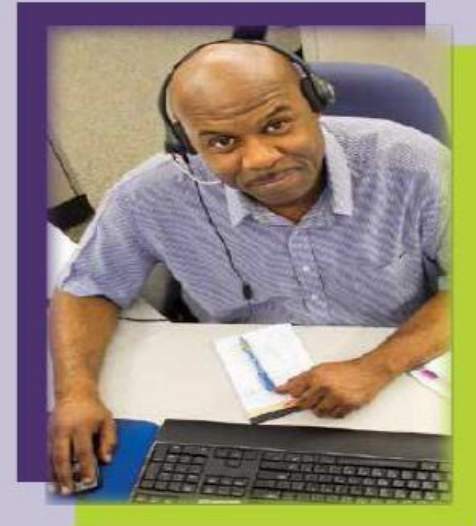
